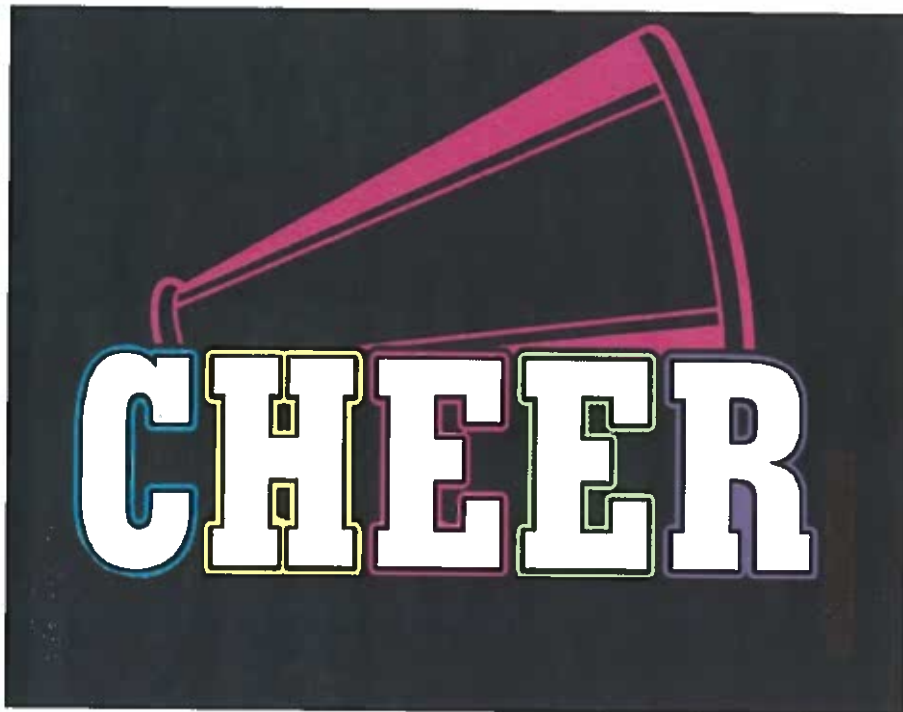

3. 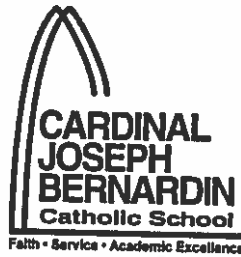
