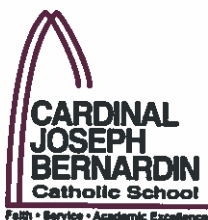


**Dear CJB Parents and Guardians:**

We have some difficult news to share.

Yesterday, we received notification from Dr. Skogsberg, Superintendent of Orland School District 135, that D135 will no longer provide bus transportation for Cardinal Joseph Bernardin students (letter attached).

As you know, we have seen this day coming for many years. In the past, we have successfully been able to re-negotiate bus service, but very unfortunately, this decision by D135 is final. We want to thank the CJB families who have worked with us over the years in an effort to maintain bus transportation.

We remain grateful for the service D135 has provided since we first opened our school and we appreciate the early notification of their decision so that our families will have time to plan for next year. Please remember that in addition to car pooling, Extended Day is available for before-school and after-school needs.

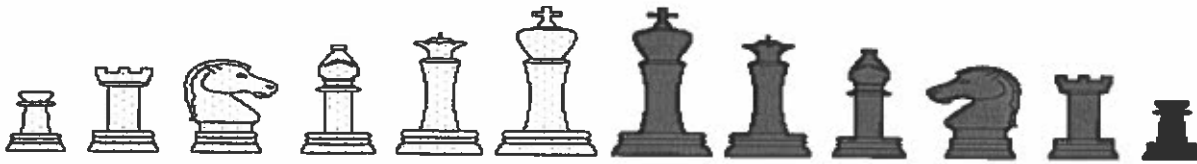

## REGISTRATION

Registration will be conducted for our Bernardin Girls and Boys Soccer Teams until Friday, January 19, 2018. Registration forms can be mailed or dropped off at the school offices during normal business hours. Any registrations received after January 19 will be put on a waiting list with no guarantee of team placement. A late fee of \$ 25.00 will be charged for all late registrants who are placed on teams. Team placement requests will not be honored. Please carefully read all the information on this registration form. Keep the top portion of this form for reference about the parent meeting.

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- Open to girls and boys in grades 3-8 who are students of Cardinal Bernardin School.
- Students must be in good academic standing
- Students must make a serious commitment to the program once practices and games begin. Players will not be allowed to miss practices or games for other sports or activities. Do not register your daughter or son if you cannot make this commitment.

League/Season: Our teams will compete in the Southwest Catholic Soccer Association. The games will start around the middle of March and run until the beginning of June. Games days have not been determined but most likely will be played one day during the week and one day on the weekend. Most teams will also have the possibility of competing in one or two tournaments.

Practices: Practices should be starting sometime in late February. Practice schedules will be set once all coaches have been selected. Practices will be conducted during the week after school, in the evenings and possibly on the weekends at the discretion of the volunteer coach and his/her schedule. Unexcused absences from practices/games will not be permitted.

Fees: The fee to play will be \$130 which includes league fees, uniform, and field rental for practices and games if needed. **PLEASE TURN IN THIS COMPLETED FORM BY January 19<sup>th</sup>. **Parent Meeting:** There will be a **MANDATORY** parent meeting for **NEW ATHLETES and their PARENTS** sometime early February. Parents will be notified by email when the meeting is scheduled. **ALL NEW athletes and at least one parent must be present at this meeting.** Personal information sheets, waivers, medical authorization forms and handbook guidelines will be discussed. Athletes will try on sample uniforms at this meeting. Policies regarding excused and unexcused absences will be discussed at this meeting. We will also discuss the specifics of the soccer season.

**Uniforms:** Our uniforms will be the same style and design as last year. Samples of the uniform will be available sometime early January. Athletes can try on uniforms at this time by contacting the Athletic Director and setting up a day and time.. All athletes are encouraged to do so. **UNIFORMS WILL BE ORDERED ON FEBRUARY 9, 2018.** Once the uniform order has been placed, no changes will be made. Athletes that wish to make changes to their uniform once the order has been placed will be referred to the supplier. Additional fees charged by the supplier will be the responsibility of the athlete and his family.

**Physicals:** All athletes must have a current physical on file with the school in order to participate in the Bernardin athletic programs. The Archdiocese requires that all athletes have a current physical on file authorizing them to participate in sports programs. The physical must cover the entire term of the sports season. Our spring sports program runs from March 10, 2018 until June 15, 2018. A current physical is one that is dated from June 15, 2017 to the present date. Physicals are due by March 10, 2018. Copies of the physical form should be turned in to the Athletic Director. **Athletes that do not have a current physical on file will not be allowed to participate in practices or games.** If you need a physical form, please contact the athletic director.

**Additional Requirement:** ALL PLAYERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SHOW PROOF OF INSURANCE.

**Team placement:** The Southwest Catholic Soccer Association has multiple grade levels of competition. Depending upon registration, this will determine the number of teams we have. We are planning on having teams at the 3<sup>rd</sup> / 4<sup>th</sup> grade level, 5<sup>th</sup> / 6<sup>th</sup> grade level and the 7<sup>th</sup> / 8<sup>th</sup> grade level. Girls and Boys teams will be separate; we will NOT have co-ed teams. If multiple teams exist at a certain grade level(s), a skill assessment may be conducted. Players and parents will be notified of the day and time if a skill assessment is needed. All decisions on team placement will be final. Request for team placement will not be honored. Rosters may be capped at the discretion of the Athletic Director.
